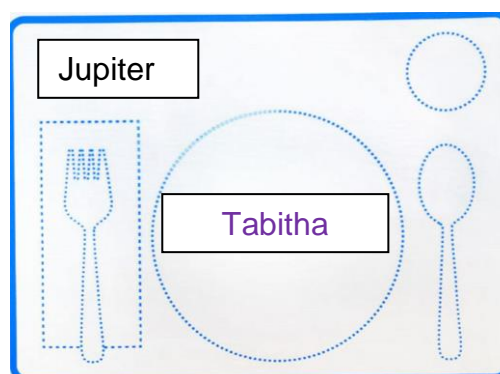
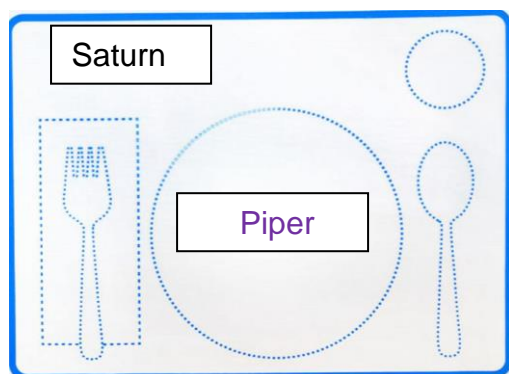
Safety First

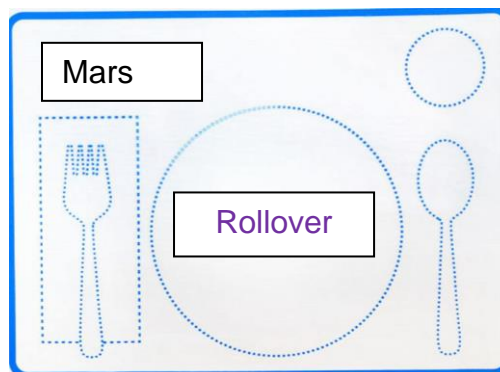
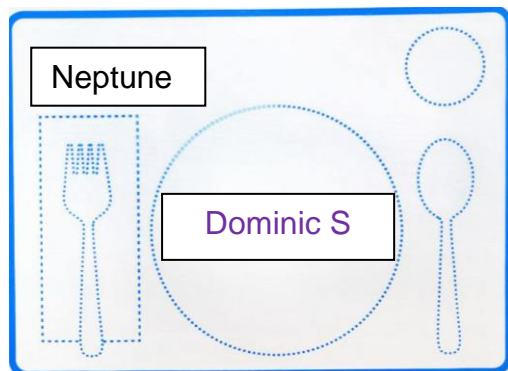
