



World Book Day


This year World Book Day will be celebrated on Thursday 5th March. An extra special day in this year of reading.



Parking

Further to my message about parking on The Green I have discovered that one of the incidents actually happened on Westgate Street rather than The Green.

I understand that some people park in Westgate Street to avoid The Green. However parking here often leaves no space for waiting cars to pass. With non-school traffic driving past at pick up time (often faster than they should be), it makes it extremely dangerous for children walking out into the road as there is little to no visibility due to cars parking so close to the lane leading up to the back gate, already causing at least one near miss.




