Belfast	the <b>capital city of Northern Ireland</b> on the east coast
Londonderry	the <b>second-largest city in Northern Ireland</b>
republic	a state in which <b>supreme power is held by the people who have an elected president</b> rather than a monarch
partition	the dividing of a country into <b>separate areas of government</b>
Lough Neagh	a <b>lake in Northern Ireland</b> and the largest lake in the British Isles
Giant's Causeway	an <b>area of basalt columns</b> ; the result of an ancient volcanic eruption
Unionists	people who are in <b>favour of the union</b> of Northern Ireland with Great Britain
Nationalists	people who <b>supports political independence</b> for a country


