## Service Obligation

- Funded applicants will sign contracts with the State Department of Oklahoma committing to:
- Serving a two (2) year full-time part-time service obligation at an approved OK Health Corps work site.
- Full-time service is defined at a minimum of forty (40) hours per week while part-time service is defined as twenty (20) hours per week, for a minimum of forty-five (45) weeks per service year. At least thirty-two hours for full time and sixteen hours for part time service must be spent providing face-to-face direct patient services during normally scheduled office hours.
- If working in a HRSA-funded Teaching Health Center, teaching activities performed by participants in the Teaching Health Center Graduate Medical Education program authorized under 42 U.S.C. § 256h, can include up to twenty (20) hours per week for full-time participants (Part-time is ten, 10).
