Pirate Adventure Camp: Sailing the Seven Seas



Set sail for a summer of imagination and discovery! In our **Pirate Adventure Camp**, explorers will journey across the "Seven Seas," traveling each week to a brand-new **imaginary island** filled with exciting adventures.

Young pirates will search for treasure, follow maps, meet colorful creatures, and solve playful challenges as they explore islands like **Treasure Cove, Parrot Island, Mermaid Lagoon, and Dragon Mountain**. Along the way, children will build important early learning skills through hands-on, play-based activities designed especially for our Pre-K campers.

Each island adventure will include: literacy activities such as storytelling, pirate vocabulary, and map reading. Math exploration through counting treasure, sorting shells, and simple problem solving. Science discoveries like floating ships, melting ice treasures, and exploring ocean and jungle animals. Creative art projects inspired by pirates, sea creatures, and magical islands. Dramatic play aboard our classroom pirate ship. Movement and outdoor adventures including treasure hunts and obstacle courses. Sensory play with sand, water, and hands-on exploration.
