Our Philosophy

Our summer program blends fun, adventure, creativity and learning. SELC is a place for children to learn, grow, and thrive in positive and unique ways that will change their young lives forever. The Summer program focuses on science and nature, arts and crafts, literature and language, music and movement, sports and games, and so much more! Research shows that children experience the deepest, most genuine learning when they are having fun! We strive to ensure that children become confident learners by concentrating our focus on meeting the needs of each individual child. We have designed our programs to provide a wonderful experience for all children.



STEAM Education is an approach to teaching and learning that combines science, technology, engineering, the arts, and math to guide student inquiry, discussion, and problem-solving. Education experts say STEAM education is about more than developing practical skills alone.

STEAM Education uses the 5 pillars as access points for **guiding student inquiry, dialogue, and critical thinking**. Through fun experiments, STEAM learning activities encourage children to **hone their observation skills, find patterns, analyze results, and predict outcomes**. Introducing this type of scientific thinking to little learners instills essential critical thinking skills, and helps them become better problem solvers.

Passport to Adventure

Pack your bags and grab your passport—this summer, we're traveling the globe! In Passport to Adventure, campers will explore different countries and cultures each week through hands-on, multi-disciplinary activities. Campers will engage in art, science, literacy, math, movement, and social-emotional learning while discovering traditions, animals, foods, and landmarks from around the world. Each camper will create a travel journal and collect passport stamps as they "visit" new destinations.

Our adventure begins in **North America (USA & Canada)**, where campers will visit **Niagara Falls**, explore **Yellowstone National Park**, and create projects inspired by major cities and natural wonders. Then, we head to **Central & South America (Mexico, Brazil, Peru)** to discover **Chichen Itza**, the **Amazon Rainforest**, and **Machu Picchu**, while enjoying colorful art, music, and cultural crafts.

Next stop—**Europe (France, Italy, UK)**! Campers will tour the **Eiffel Tower**, **Colosseum**, and **Big Ben**, design their own landmarks, and experience classic traditions. In **Africa (Kenya, Egypt, South Africa)**, they'll go on a "safari," learn about animals of the **Savanna**, explore the **Pyramids of Giza**, and discover diverse cultures.

Our journey continues through **Asia (China, Japan, India)**, where campers will "walk" along the **Great Wall of China**, create Japanese-inspired art, and celebrate colorful Indian traditions. Then, we travel down under to **Australia & New Zealand** to learn about unique wildlife like kangaroos and kiwi birds, and explore the **Great Barrier Reef**.

Bundle up as we explore the icy regions of the **Arctic & Antarctica**, learning about glaciers, penguins, and polar bears through fun science activities. In the **Middle East**, campers will discover ancient history and architecture, exploring places like the **Pyramids**, markets, and desert landscapes through hands-on crafts and storytelling.

Finally, we'll relax in the sunny **Caribbean**, where campers will enjoy island-inspired games, music, and art while learning about ocean life and tropical cultures.

Each destination comes to life through interactive activities, creative projects, games, music, and "travel experiences" that inspire curiosity and imagination. Pack your passport—this is a summer adventure around the world you'll never forget! ☺
