Our Philosophy

Our summer program blends fun, adventure, creativity and learning. SELC is a place for children to learn, grow, and thrive in positive and unique ways that will change their young lives forever. The summer program focuses on science and nature, arts and crafts, literature and language, music and movement, sports and games, and so much more! Research shows that children experience the deepest, most genuine learning when they are having fun! We strive to ensure that children become confident learners by concentrating our focus on meeting the needs of each individual child. We have designed our programs to provide a wonderful experience for all children.



Our program also incorporates STEAM, which stands for Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics. STEAM education programs aim to teach students to think critically and have an engineering and design approach towards real-world problems while building on their mathematics and science base. STEAM programs add art to STEM curriculum by drawing on design principles and encouraging creative solutions.

The Wonderful World of Animals

Get ready for a joyful summer adventure designed especially for toddlers, where curious little learners explore the wonderful world of animals through play, creativity, and discovery! In this multi-disciplinary experience, children will be introduced to animals from farms, oceans, jungles, and even their own backyards. Through hands-on activities, songs, stories, movement, and sensory play, toddlers will begin to understand how animals live, what they eat, the sounds they make, and how they move.

Each day is filled with opportunities to learn through different subjects woven together naturally. In early science exploration, children will observe animal features like fur, feathers, and scales, and discover simple ideas about habitat - who lives in the water, in trees, or on the ground. Through art, toddlers will paint, build, and craft animals using a variety of textures and materials, helping them develop fine motor skills and creativity. Music and movement bring animals to life as children stomp like elephants, hop like bunnies, and flap like birds, strengthening coordination and body awareness.

Language development is supported through storytelling, picture books, and interactive conversations, where children learn new words related to animals and their environments. Early math concepts are gently introduced as toddlers sort animals by size, count toy creatures, and recognize patterns in colors and shapes. Sensory play stations - like water tables, sand bins, and soft animal figurines - encourage exploration and imaginative play while supporting cognitive growth.

This enriching summer experience also nurtures social-emotional development. Children practice sharing, taking turns, and expressing excitement as they learn alongside their peers. Gentle conversations about caring for animals and nature help build empathy and an early sense of responsibility for the world around them.

By the end of the summer, children will not only recognize a variety of animals, but also develop confidence, curiosity, and a love for learning that will carry into their future adventures.

Wet & Wild Wednesdays

On hot days, it's a great way to cool off, but there is much more to water play! It provides hours of rich and valuable experiences to develop children's creativity and imagination. It is both enjoyable and educational. It helps children develop hand-eye coordination, as well as math and science concepts. It also enhances social skills and encourages cooperation.

Our Toddlers will increase their fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination through actions like pouring,



squirting, scrubbing, stirring and squeezing.

Water play is also an amazing sensory experience that introduces them to textures (slippery, slimy...) and temperatures. It allows children to explore a substance and make discoveries about it. Above all, it encourages them to use their imagination and develops creative thinking. Water play releases energy; it can be both invigorating or relaxing and calming for young children. Gentle water play allows them to unwind, order their thoughts and relax. It also encourages role play and crucial social skills like teamwork and sharing. They learn to work with one or more children, to take turns and share the space and accessories with their friends.
