Message from the President

Over the past year, the Gamma Mu Foundation has taken important steps to modernize and strengthen our connection with donors. After 38 years, we recognized the need to embrace new tools and fresh approaches to better serve our donor community and engage younger generations of supporters.



With the help of a consulting partnership, we've automated key processes in our NEON system. Donations are now recorded instantly, donors receive recognition messages based on their giving level, and each donor can log into a personal account to view giving history and update contact information.

We also launched a new website featuring news, events, and improved access to reports. Our newsletters are expanding to include stories about scholarship and grant recipients, along with insights from donors and board members.

When Cliff Pettit announced the closing of the Gamma Mu Social group, we introduced regional donor gatherings, including the very successful inaugural Celebration West. These events will continue in the year ahead as part of our efforts to bring the community together.

As we begin our fall appeal, I invite you to continue supporting this work. With your generosity, we will build on last year's record awards, add new named scholarships and grants, and remain committed to uplifting LGBTQ+ communities, especially in rural and underserved areas.

Summer Meeting 2025 Highlights: Stronger Grants, Record Scholarships, Deeper Connections

The Gamma Mu Foundation is celebrating a year of record-breaking scholarships, stronger grants, and deeper connections with our donor community. Together, we're not just funding programs, we're building a shared story of progress, belonging, and lasting change. Strong Financial Standing

 President John Ellis shared that the Foundation's accounts stood at \$5.4 million as of June 30, 2025.

Grants and Scholarships

- 21 grants totaling **\$193,399** were awarded this year.
- 10 Community Support Services projects, 10 HIV & Health Initiatives, and 1 Public Education & Research project,
- Applications were stronger than ever, thanks to clearer guidelines and our first-ever webinars with 200+ participants.

On the scholarship side, the Foundation reached a new milestone:


- 47 scholarships awarded, totaling **\$160,000**; the highest number in our history.
- 41% increase in scholarship funding since 2023.
- Nearly two-thirds grew up in communities under 50,000 people.
- Several Named Scholarship winners shared moving thank-you notes and stories.

- Friday night: Dinner hosted by Board Secretary Bill Hayden at his home.
- Sunday morning: A Chicago Architecture Center River Cruise aboard the First Lady, with Bill himself as tour lead, a highlight for many participants.

The 2025 Summer Meeting showed how much we can accomplish together. **Most importantly, it underscored that Gamma Mu's story is powered by its donors.** You're not just seeing the results of your giving, you're part of the work itself, helping to build a future defined by equity, opportunity, and lasting impact in our community.



Full-Cycle Support for Grant Applicants

On August 26, 2025, the Gamma Mu Foundation hosted a 90-minute post-application webinar for more than 30 organizations whose proposals were not selected. Participants received constructive feedback, insights into how the Grants Committee evaluates proposals, and strategies to strengthen future submissions, not only to the Foundation but to other small grant funders as well.

Mark Hendon, Grants Committee Chair, emphasized, "While some proposals were not selected for funding in this cycle, we value the vital work these organizations are doing to support the LGBTQ+ community, and our goal is to help every applicant grow stronger for future opportunities."

Grant Spotlight

Wyoming Equality's Healthcare Access Project brings affirming care to LGBTQ communities statewide with Gamma Mu Foundation support



Accessing affirming healthcare is still a major challenge for LGBTQ+ people in Wyoming, especially in rural communities. That's why the Gamma Mu Foundation is proud to support Wyoming Equality's Healthcare Access Project (WEHAP).

Since 2017, we've awarded eight grants totaling \$41,400, including a \$15,000 grant in 2025. With this support, WEHAP has:

- Trained nearly 120 providers in LGBTQ-inclusive care
- Reached thousands of LGBTQ individuals with HIV/STD testing, PrEP navigation, and community outreach

 Launched the Affirming Care ECHO, a statewide education series for healthcare professionals


