General Rules—for all ages

Substitutions

Unlimited substitutions can be made at any stoppage of play and must be approved by the official.

Headers

NO heading in games or practices.

Punting

NO punting in games or practices.

Fouls

All free kicks are indirect.

Halftime

5 minutes

Misconduct

No card or send off. Coach will replace the player.

Penalty kick

No penalty kicks.

Safety

- If player is hurt, stop play immediately.
- Restart with indirect kick for team that had possession.

Player equipment

- Players may not wear ANY JEWELRY or EARRINGS during a soccer game. Earrings, even newly pierced, must be removed in order to play.
- Players may not wear or use anything that is dangerous to themselves or another player.
- All players must wear shin guards, covered by socks.
- Eyeglasses must be secured by a headband.
- Jackets, sweatpants are OK, hoodie must have hood tucked under jersey.

Coaches/parents

- Players and coaches should be on one side of the field; parents and spectators on opposite side of field.
- Opposing players and coaches should line up and shake hands or applaud as group after each game.
