8. To receive an operations report from EMS Chief and take any necessary action related to the Chief's report, including review and approval of any agreements and/or contracts.
9. To review and act to approve the purchase, funding, financing and payment for capital assets, including construction, vehicles, EMS apparatus and equipment and for non-capital items and expenses.
10. To review, discuss and take action for the sale or disposal of obsolete surplus and/or salvage property pursuant to Texas Health and Safety Code §775.0735.
11. To set meeting date for May 2026.
12. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.071 to consult with legal counsel regarding pending or contemplated litigation, settlement offers or on matters which require confidentiality under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas.
13. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.072 to deliberate regarding real estate matters.
14. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.074 to discuss personnel matters.
15. To review and act on real estate matters, including but not limited to purchase, sale, resolutions, and other matters related to real property transactions, including acquisition financing.
16. To review and act on personnel matters, including policies, scheduling, evaluations, benefits, compensation, hiring, retention or termination of District employees, including District EMS Chief, command staff, administrative staff, and medical personnel.
