“After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them two by two ahead of him to every town and place where he was about to go.” – Luke 10:1 (NIV)

This conference is about sending, not spectating.

Objective:

FCA leaders are called to continually invest in their own spiritual growth. The \$12 registration is a symbolic and intentional act—representing the 12 disciples—that declares:

“I am committed to growing in Christ so others may see His light through me.”

Secondly, we are leveraging our God-given influence to recruit and inspire 72 student leaders to register for the Proven Conference. Just as Jesus sent out the 72, we believe God is raising up a generation of student leaders ready to be sent into their schools as missionaries.

Together, standing united as one front, we will get the right change agents on the bus—students prepared to lead, serve, and advance the Kingdom of God.

CONFERENCE LEADERSHIP STRUCTURE

(4 CORE LEADERS)

1. Conference Coordinator – Captain (Overall Lead)

Role: Spiritual & operational oversight of the entire Proven Conference

- Cast vision and align conference with FCA mission & Proven Theme
- Lead prayer and spiritual tone
- Decision-maker for schedule, speakers, and flow
- Oversees all coordinators

2. Operations & Logistics Coordinator (Co-Captain)

Role: Execution, timing, facilities, and people flow

- Oversees setup, teardown, room readiness, signage, and supplies
- Manages servant leader scheduling and rotations
- Coordinates safety, check-in, and facilities use

3. Corporate Worship Coordinator (Co-Captain)

Role: Corporate worship, keynote flow, and spiritual environment

- Oversees worship, prayer teams, speakers, and AV
- Protects worship environment and transitions
- Ensures Christ-centered excellence

4. Discipleship Coordinator (Co-Captain)

Role: Student leaders, breakout sessions, and discipleship focus

- Coaches student teachers and breakout leaders
- Oversees huddles, prayer response, and follow-up
- Champions student ownership and leadership development

THE \$12 + 72 LEADERSHIP CHALLENGE

Luke 10:1 (NIV)

“After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them two by two ahead of him to every town and place where he was about to go.”
