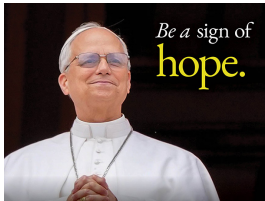
**DIRECTOR OF TEMPORAL GOODS****(Parish Finances, Facilities, Operations)**

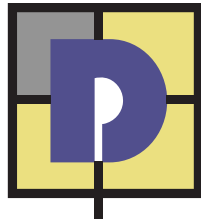
