sporting events or family outings, movie tickets and gift cards. We appreciate any and all donations and as always, thank you for your continued support.

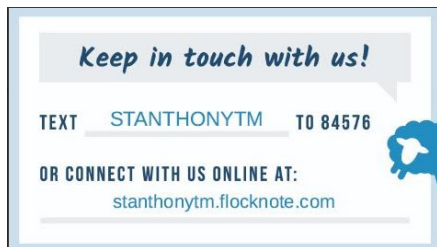
MADISON AVENUE CHRISTIAN CHURCH

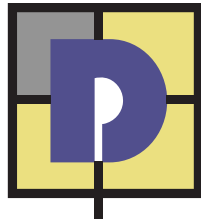
