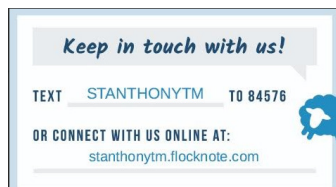
2026 DOMESTIC NEEDS COMBINED COLLECTION

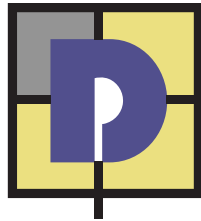
