gift cards. We appreciate any and all donations and as always, thank you for your continued support.

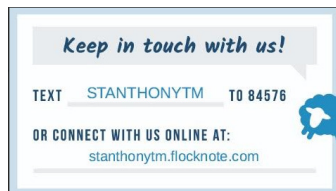

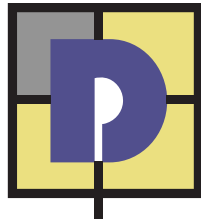
