Icebreaker

How do you prefer to learn? Reading? Listening?
Being shown how to do something? Talking things through?

Scripture Reference

Acts 17:1-15

Intro

Has there been a message from this series that has stuck out to you? What and why?

Pastor Matt talked about how the Bereans searched the scripture daily

In your own words, why do you think it's important that we search and study scripture?

Pastor Matt talked about doctrine and how we sometimes bend scripture to fit our doctrines.

Do you have an example of this? Has there been something that was taught, probably out of a good space, that you later (or now) find does not line up with your beliefs about what scripture is saying?

Pastor Matt told us to have humility when we search and study the scriptures

Why do you think it is important for us to have humility? If you are honest today, would you say you are humble when reading and studying scripture? What about interacting with others in discussion?

How often do you personally read and study scripture? If it is infrequent, what keeps you from being more consistent?

What is one thing this week you can do this week to grow in your Biblical literacy?

Takeaway: "Scripture should shape our doctrine, not the other way around."

Takeaway: "Biblical literacy is essential for spiritual growth."

Why do you think it is 'essential' for growth?

Takeaway: "Faith grows when we search Scripture personally."

Is there a desire for deeper intimacy with the Lord? Why or why not? What are you doing to create fertile soil for the Lord to produce the fruit of the Spirit in your life?
