Statement from Bishop Joseph Williams on Settlement with Sexual Abuse Survivors

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I write to you today with news of profound significance for the Catholic Church of South Jersey and especially for those who have been harmed by clergy sexual abuse. Last week, the Official Committee of Tort Claimant Creditors (the Survivors' Committee) unanimously agreed to accept the terms of a final bankruptcy settlement with the Diocese of Camden. The proposed plan establishes a trust of \$180 million, funded by the Diocese, its Parishes and the various insurers that insured the Diocese in the past, which will be made available to resolve all claims of abuse upon approval by the Bankruptcy Court. *For the survivors of South Jersey, this day is long overdue and represents a milestone in their journey toward restored justice and the healing and recognition they have long sought and deserve.

To each one of those survivors, I would like to say: Thank you for your courage in coming forward. Without your bravery and persistence, this new day would not have dawned. I am profoundly sorry for what you have suffered. It was a grave sin and a devastating betrayal of the trust you placed in the Church that you loved. I cannot remove the scars you carry nor restore the innocence you lost, but on behalf of my predecessors and the faithful of Camden I can say clearly and without reservation: We believe you, we are sorry and we are committed to walking a different path going forward with you, God willing, at our side.

I have been humbled these past months by the trust you have shown me and others in the Diocese by sharing your stories with us. They were at once heart-breaking and awe-inspiring. You are living witnesses of the truth that where sin abounds grace abounds even more! I believe that as more of the faithful of South Jersey hear your stories, you will become prophets of a stronger and more transparent Church. I cannot wait to get to know you better and to work with you to rebuild trust and restore hope. Please know that you remain in my heart and in my prayers in the meantime.

To all the faithful of South Jersey: thank you for the patience and grace you have shown in this extremely painful chapter of our local Church's history. I know that you will help me in the coming weeks and months to open wide the doors to Christ for all those who have been hurt by the Church.

To our priests, deacons, religious, diocesan employees, parish staff and educators: Thank you for remaining committed to the Gospel in the face of great challenges. Your integrity and perseverance matter. It may seem that today's announcement is the end of a complex and sometime contentious legal process, but I invite you to see it as the beginning of a new day which allows our local Church to carry on its mission of making the name of Jesus known and loved in South Jersey with renewed vigor.

My approval of this agreement was given with the overwhelming support of the Diocese's College of Consultors and the Diocesan Finance Council. I want to thank them for putting compassion for the survivors at the forefront of their decision-making and for their willingness, in final analysis, to make a significant financial stretch in order to make the Church's concern for the survivors even more credible.

Finally, I would like to recognize the work of my predecessor, Bishop Dennis Sullivan, who promised to the survivors that he would implement the strongest safe environment policies in the country and who delivered on that promise. There is no greater way to honor the sufferings of those who have been harmed than to work day-in and day-out to make sure that something like this never happens again.

May Christ, who heals the brokenhearted and makes all things new, bless us all and make us one in Him.

El segundo domingo de Cuaresma 2026 (1 de marzo) se centra en el Evangelio de la **Transfiguración de Jesús**, donde muestra su gloria a Pedro, Santiago y Juan para fortalecerlos antes de la Pasión. Este pasaje revela la divinidad de Cristo, anticipa la Resurrección y subraya la escucha de la "voz del Amado".

Puntos Clave de la Explicación Católica:

- **La Transfiguración como anticipo:** Jesús se transfigura en el monte para preparar a sus discípulos ante el escándalo de la cruz, demostrando que su sufrimiento no es una derrota, sino el camino a la gloria.
- **Escucha a Jesús:** La voz del Padre ("Este es mi Hijo, mi Elegido; escuchadlo") invita a los fieles a centrarse en la palabra de Dios, especialmente en el contexto del desierto interior cuaresmal.
- **La meta es la Gloria:** Así como Jesús mostró su naturaleza divina, la Cuaresma busca recordar a los fieles su destino final: la Pascua de la Resurrección y la vida eterna.

Declaración del obispo José Williams sobre el acuerdo con los sobrevivientes de abuso sexual

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Les escribo hoy con noticias de gran importancia para la Iglesia Católica del sur de Nueva Jersey, y en especial, para aquellos que han sido víctimas de abuso sexual por parte del clero. La semana pasada, el Comité Oficial de Acreedores Demandantes por Daños y Perjuicios (el Comité de Supervivientes) acordó por unanimidad aceptar los términos de un acuerdo final de bancarrota con la Diócesis de Camden. El plan propuesto establece un fideicomiso de 180 millones de dólares, financiado por la Diócesis, sus parroquias y las diversas aseguradoras que aseguraron a la diócesis en el pasado, que se pondrá a disposición para resolver todas las reclamaciones por abusos tras la aprobación del Tribunal de Bancarrotas. * Para los supervivientes del sur de Nueva Jersey, este día llega con mucho retraso y representa un hito en su camino hacia la restauración de la justicia, la sanación y el reconocimiento que tanto han buscado y que tanto merecen.

A cada uno de esos supervivientes, me gustaría decirles: Gracias por su valentía al dar un paso al frente. Sin su valentía y perseverancia, este nuevo día no habría surgido. Lamento profundamente lo que han sufrido. Fue un grave pecado y una traición devastadora a la confianza que depositaron en la Iglesia que amaban. No puedo borrar las cicatrices que llevan ni devolverles la inocencia que perdieron, pero en nombre de mis predecesores y de los fieles de Camden puedo decirles con claridad y sin reservas: les creemos, lo sentimos y nos comprometemos a recorrer un camino diferente en el futuro con ustedes, si Dios quiere, a nuestro lado.

Me siento honrado por la confianza que ustedes han depositado en mí y en otros miembros de la Diócesis al compartir sus historias con nosotros durante estos últimos meses. Fueron a la vez desgarradoras e inspiradoras. ¡Ustedes son testigos vivos de la verdad de que donde abunda el pecado, abunda aún más la gracia! Creo que, a medida que más fieles del sur de Nueva Jersey escuchen sus historias, ustedes se convertirán en profetas de una Iglesia más fuerte y transparente. Estoy deseando conocerlos mejor y trabajar con ustedes para reconstruir la confianza y restaurar la esperanza. Por favor, sepan que, mientras tanto, permanecen en mi corazón y en mis oraciones.

A todos los fieles del sur de Nueva Jersey: gracias por la paciencia y la dignidad que han demostrado en este capítulo tan doloroso de la historia de nuestra Iglesia local. Sé que me ayudarán en las próximas semanas y meses a abrir de par en par las puertas a Cristo para todos aquellos que han sido heridos por la Iglesia.

A nuestros sacerdotes, diáconos, religiosos, empleados diocesanos, personal parroquial y educadores: gracias por seguir comprometidos con el Evangelio ante los grandes desafíos. Su integridad y perseverancia son importantes. Puede parecer que el anuncio de hoy es el final de un proceso legal complejo y, en ocasiones, polémico, pero los invito a verlo como el comienzo de un nuevo día que permite a nuestra Iglesia local continuar con su misión de dar a conocer y amar el nombre de Jesús en el sur de Nueva Jersey con renovado vigor.

Mi aprobación de este acuerdo se dio con el apoyo abrumador del Colegio de Consultores de la Diócesis y del Consejo Financiero Diocesano. Quiero agradecerles por poner la compasión por los sobrevivientes al frente de su toma de decisiones y por su disposición, en última instancia, a hacer un esfuerzo financiero significativo para que la preocupación de la Iglesia por los sobrevivientes sea aún más creíble.

Por último, me gustaría reconocer la labor de mi predecesor, el obispo Dennis Sullivan, quien prometió a los supervivientes que aplicaría las políticas de entorno seguro más estrictas del país y quien cumplió esa promesa. No hay mejor manera de honrar el sufrimiento de quienes han sido perjudicados que trabajar día tras día para garantizar que algo así no vuelva a suceder jamás.

Que Cristo, que sana los corazones quebrantados y renueva todas las cosas, nos bendiga a todos y nos haga uno en Él.
