El tercer domingo de Cuaresma, Ciclo A (8 de marzo de 2026), se centra en la conversión y la sed de Dios a través del encuentro de Jesús con la samaritana, presentándolo como el "agua viva" que sacia toda sed. Se enfatiza la necesidad de adorar "en espíritu y en verdad" y la misión de ser portadores de este mensaje.

Puntos Clave de la Explicación Católica:

- **Jesús como Agua Viva (Evangelio Juan 4):** Jesús se revela a la samaritana como el Mesías y la fuente de agua viva que da vida eterna. La Cuaresma es el tiempo para reconocer nuestra sed interior y acercarnos a Él para ser saciados.
- **Conversión y Verdadero Culto:** Jesús trasciende los lugares geográficos de culto (templo vs. monte) y explica que los verdaderos adoradores adoran al Padre "en espíritu y en verdad". Esto exige una conversión del corazón, no solo ritos externos.
