



El color rosa simboliza una alegría atenuada, un respiro dentro del tiempo penitencial de la Cuaresma.

Domingo Laetare introduce una nota de esperanza y gozo ante la cercanía de la Pascua.

**Significado de "Laetare"**



## Vía Crucis Eucarístico Pasión Y Muerte de Jesucristo



La expresión latina "Vía Crucis" significa "camino de la Cruz", es decir, el que recorrió Cristo durante su Pasión, desde el Pretorio de Pilatos hasta el Calvario. Dicha expresión se utiliza también de modo habitual para designar una forma de oración acompañada de meditación sobre los acontecimientos ocurridos en ese camino de Cristo, al que se añaden el hecho de su muerte en la cruz, el descendimiento de la misma y su sepultura. Junto a diversas oraciones, en general de penitencia y arrepentimiento, se van intercalando catorce meditaciones, que se llaman «estaciones», porque los que hacen este ejercicio de piedad se «estacionan» o detienen unos momentos para meditar en cada una de las estaciones.




