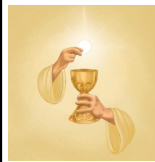

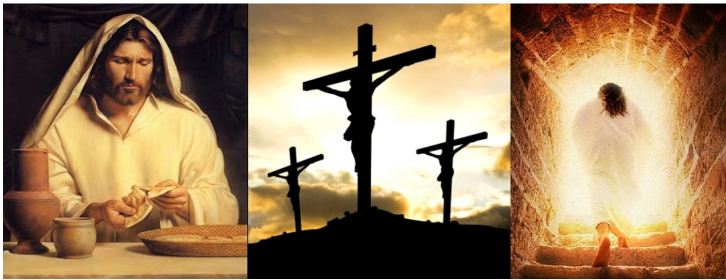

El **Domingo de Ramos de 2026** se celebrará el **29 de marzo**. Para la Iglesia Católica, este día es la "puerta de entrada" a la Semana Santa y tiene un significado dual: la alegría por el triunfo de Cristo y el anuncio de su sacrificio.

A continuación, la explicación detallada según la tradición y liturgia católica:

#### 1. El Significado de la Celebración

- **Entrada Triunfal:** Se conmemora la llegada de Jesús a Jerusalén a lomos de un burrito, donde fue recibido por una multitud que lo aclamó como el Mesías y Rey de la paz.

- **Contradicción Humana:** La liturgia refleja cómo la misma multitud que gritó "¡Hosanna!" (Sálvanos) ese domingo, pocos días después exigió su muerte gritando "¡Crucifícalo!".

**Humildad:** Al elegir un pollino en lugar de un caballo de guerra, Jesús muestra que su reino no es de poder terrenal, sino de servicio y humildad.

#### 2. Elementos Litúrgicos Clave

- **Bendición de las Palmas:** Antes de la Misa, los fieles llevan ramos (generalmente de palma u olivo) que son bendecidos. Estos simbolizan la victoria y la fe de quienes reconocen a Jesús como su Señor.

- **La Procesión:** Representa el camino de la Iglesia que sigue a Cristo hacia su Pasión.

- **Color Rojo:** Es el color litúrgico de este día, simbolizando la sangre derramada por Jesús y su condición de Rey.

- **Lectura de la Pasión:** A diferencia de otros domingos, durante la Misa se lee el relato completo de la Pasión del Señor (el juicio, calvario y muerte), preparando a los fieles para el Triduo Pascual.
