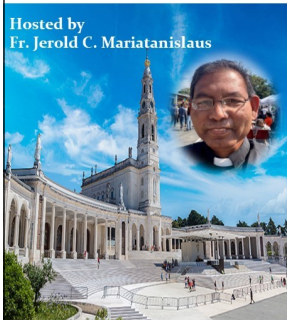

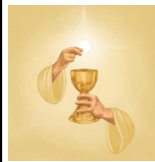

## Domingo de la Divina Misericordia

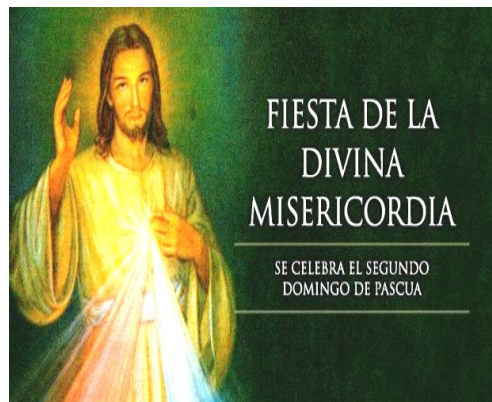

### ¿Cuál es el significado del Domingo de la Divina Misericordia?

El primer domingo después de Pascua se celebra el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, que es el último día de la octava de Pascua. En 2026, esta fiesta es el 12 de abril.

En las revelaciones sobre la Divina Misericordia que hizo a Santa Faustina, Jesús le pidió en varias ocasiones que se dedicara una fiesta a la Divina Misericordia, y que fuera el domingo siguiente a Pascua. Los textos litúrgicos de ese día, el segundo domingo de Pascua, tratan sobre la institución del Sacramento de la Penitencia, el Tribunal de la Divina Misericordia, por lo que ya están en consonancia con el pedido de Nuestro Señor.



Esta Fiesta, que ya se había concedido a Polonia y se había celebrado en la Ciudad del Vaticano, fue otorgada a la Iglesia Universal por el Papa Juan Pablo II en ocasión de la canonización de Sor Faustina el 30 de abril de 2000. En un decreto con fecha 23 de mayo de 2000, la Congregación para el Culto Divino y la Disciplina de los Sacramentos declaró que “en todo el mundo, el Segundo Domingo de Pascua recibirá el nombre de **Domingo de la Divina Misericordia**, una invitación perenne para el mundo cristiano a afrontar, con confianza en la benevolencia divina, las dificultades y las pruebas que esperan al género humano en los años venideros”.

**Respecto a la Fiesta de la Misericordia, Jesús dijo:**

**Quien se acerque ese día a la Fuente de Vida recibirá el perdón total de las culpas y de las penas. (Diario, 300) Indulgencia Plenaria: La Iglesia otorga indulgencia plenaria a los fieles que comulguen con la debida disposición y hagan una oración piadosa a la Divina Misericordia en este día.**

- ◆ **Confesión sacramental:** Realizada días antes o en el mismo día.
- ◆ **Comunión eucarística:** Recibir la Eucaristía el domingo de la fiesta.
- ◆ **Oración por las intenciones del Papa:** Rezar un Padre Nuestro y un Credo (u otra oración).
- ◆ **Actos de Piedad:** Participar en una iglesia en oraciones en honor a la Divina Misericordia, o ante el Sagrario rezar el Padre Nuestro, el Credo y una invocación piadosa (ej. "Jesús misericordioso, confío en Ti").
- ◆ **Desapego total del pecado:** Tener el corazón libre de afecto a cualquier pecado, incluso venial.
