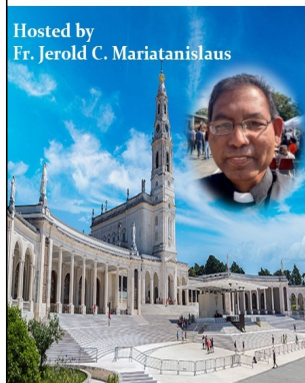

May is *Mental Health Awareness Month*.

Awareness is essential in maintaining and addressing our mental health needs – at every age.

Nicole Keefer, Executive Director of VITALity Catholic Healthcare Services, along with representation from all New Jersey Catholic dioceses, recently attended a statewide Catholic Mental Health Conference hosted by the Diocese of Metuchen. Bishop John P. Dolan of the Diocese of Phoenix and a leading voice for Catholics in the mental health space was the keynote speaker. He reflected on the necessity to break the stigma around mental health and encouraged all to embrace connection and belonging as a way to mitigate isolation for those encountering mental health challenges. Bishop Dolan spoke encouraged building community and ministries of accompaniment to walk with those facing these challenges as a way to build bridges and begin healing.

As VITALity supports health, well-being and healing of the “whole person,” it’s important that we take a moment to recognize what mental health is and how our ministry works to help those facing these challenges.

Mental Health includes our ability to cope with the stresses of life, realize our abilities, learn and work well, and contribute to our community. Mental, physical and spiritual health are interconnected. VITALity meets individuals where they are and accompanies them on their journey toward hope and healing through:

- Advocating for mental health - especially for the elderly, individuals with disabilities, and their caregivers
- Personally connecting individuals with providers and resources to address individual health and well being needs
- Offering a safe, accepting space to share feelings with a compassionate listener who will empathize and provide unconditional support through our **Stephen Ministry**
- Providing weekly phone calls to those who may feel lonely or isolated through our **Calls of Joy program**
- Assisting individuals in connecting them with mental health support groups and parish ministries, including grief and caregiving
- Educating and sharing information to promote health in mind, body and spirit

Check in with yourself regularly! Be mindful of:

- Changes in mood and/or sleep patterns
- Changes in eating habits
- Unusual difficulty concentrating
- Persistent fear or constantly worrying about health, finances or other aspects of life
- Worsening of chronic health conditions

Prioritizing your mental health and seeking help when needed are important steps you can take. VITALity Catholic Healthcare Services is here to help you and your loved ones with through caring outreach and advocacy.

Padrinos de Bautismo: Lea atentamente la información sobre la Ley Canónica (reglamento de la Iglesia) sobre los padrinos del Sacramento del Bautismo. **Tenga en cuenta:** Al menos un padrino debe ser un católico practicante y debe obtener un Certificado de elegibilidad de su parroquia y enviarlo a esta oficina antes de que se pueda programar el bautismo.

Padrinos Bautismales

Con respecto a los Padrinos de bautismo, el Código de Derecho Canónico de 1983 establece:

Canon 872: En la medida de lo posible, a quien va a recibir el bautismo se le ha de dar un padrino, cuya función es asistir en su iniciación cristiana al adulto que se bautiza, y, juntamente con los padres, presentar al niño que va a recibir el bautismo y procurar que después lleve una vida cristiana congruente con el bautismo y cumpla fielmente las obligaciones inherentes al mismo.

Canon 873: Téngase un solo padrino o una sola madrina, o uno y una. Exige que haya un padrino, o una madrina, o un padrino y una madrina:

Por su parte, el canon 874 establece los requisitos para ser admitido como padrino:

Canon 874, 1: Para que alguien sea admitido como padrino, es necesario que:

1º. Haya sido elegido por quien va a bautizarse o por sus padres o por quienes ocupan su lugar o, faltando éstos, por el párroco o ministro; y que tenga capacidad para esta misión e intención de desempeñarla;

2º. Haya cumplido dieciséis años, a no ser que el Obispo diocesano establezca otra edad, o que, por justa causa, el párroco o el ministro consideren admisible una excepción;

3º. Sea católico, esté confirmado, haya recibido ya el Santísimo Sacramento de la Eucaristía y lleve, al mismo tiempo, una vida congruente con la fe y con la misión que va a asumir;

4º. No esté afectado por una pena canónica, legítimamente impuesta o declarada;

5º. No sea el padre o la madre de quien se ha de bautizar.

2: El bautizado que pertenece a una comunidad eclesial no católica sólo puede ser admitido junto con un padrino católico, y exclusivamente en calidad de testigo del bautismo.

Canon 854: El bautismo se ha de administrar por inmersión o por infusión, de acuerdo con las normas de la Conferencia Episcopal.

Canon 855: Procuren los padres, los padrinos y el párroco que no se imponga un nombre ajeno al sentir cristiano.

Canon 860, 1. Fuera del caso de necesidad, no debe administrarse el bautismo en casas particulares, a no ser que el Ordinario del lugar lo hubiera permitido por causa grave.

Preparación Sacramental

Sacramento del Bautismo

- Llenar la forma de Bautizo en la oficina parroquial
- Copia del certificado de nacimiento del niño (a)
- Padres y padrinos deberán estar registrados y ser participantes activos de la Santa Misa .
- Si los padrinos son miembros de otra Iglesia Católica deberán presentar una carta confirmando que son activos miembros de dicha Iglesia.

Sacramento de la Reconciliación

- Miércoles 6:00pm y Domingo 12:00pm

Sacramento del Matrimonio

- Llame para reunirse con el sacerdote para programar con un año de anticipación.

OCIA (Orden de Iniciación Cristiana de Adultos)

- Si desea recibir los sacramentos; ya sea Bautismo, 1ra. Comunión, o Confirmación, llame para reunirse con el sacerdote.

Funerales

- El procedimiento estándar para los católicos es un servicio de vigilia en una funeraria, o una misa fúnebre en la iglesia y un entierro formal.

Cuidado pastoral de los enfermos

- Si está en el hospital o en casa, llame a la oficina para programar visitas sacramentales.

Quinceañera

- Llame a la oficina para programar la Misa.
