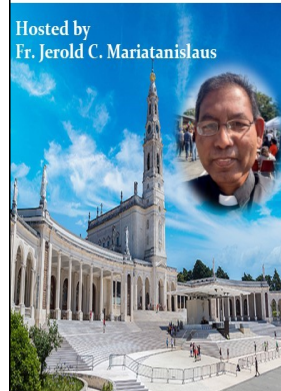



Vigilancia y compromiso:

La reparación es un llamado a estar más atentos a la presencia de Jesús en la Eucaristía y a comprometerse en una vida de santidad


