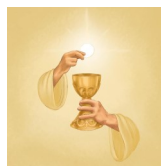

Grounds & Cemetery: Take a quiet walk through the outdoor Stations of the Cross or visit the cemetery, which includes a historic, smaller chapel

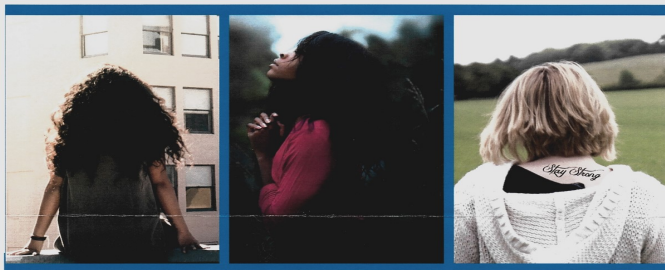

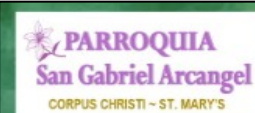
