



What Is Ash Wednesday?

Ash Wednesday 2026 marks the first day of Lent. Lent is the liturgical time lasting 40 days before Easter when Catholics prepare to commemorate Jesus’s Resurrection through prayer, penance and fasting.



Can You Eat Meat on Ash Wednesday?

No.

Catholics are required to abstain and fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Is Ash Wednesday a Holy Day of Obligation?

No, Ash Wednesday is not a Holy Day of Obligation. However, it is one of the most well-attended Masses throughout the entire liturgical year. It marks an earnest beginning to the Lenten season, inviting the faithful to witness to their Catholic faith, and mortality, by receiving ashes on their foreheads.

Ash Wednesday Prayers

Blessing of Ashes: This prayer is said by the priest when blessing the ashes that will be distributed:

O God, who are moved by acts of humility and respond with forgiveness to works of penance, lend your merciful ear to our prayers and in your kindness pour out the grace of your blessing on your servants who are marked with these ashes, that, as they follow the Lenten observances, they may be worthy to come with minds made pure to celebrate the Paschal Mystery of your Son. Through Christ our Lord Amen.

El Miércoles de Ceniza 2026 se celebra el 18 de febrero, marcando el inicio de la Cuaresma, un periodo de 40 días de reflexión, ayuno y conversión para los católicos antes de la Semana Santa. Este día simboliza la fragilidad humana, el arrepentimiento y la preparación espiritual para la resurrección de Jesús.

Marcando el inicio del tiempo de Cuaresma. La Cuaresma dura aproximadamente cuarenta días. Si cuentas los días desde el Miércoles de Ceniza hasta la Misa de la Cena del Señor del Jueves Santo, encontrarás más de cuarenta días. Por eso no son exactamente cuarenta días. Los domingos son parte de este período. Algunas personas no renuncian a cosas los domingos durante la Cuaresma, y eso está bien porque nuestros sacrificios son voluntarios. Pero ayunar el miércoles de ceniza y no comer carne los viernes durante la Cuaresma son obligatorios, a menos que seas demasiado joven o viejo.

¿Se puede comer carne el Miércoles de Ceniza? Miles de personas buscan en Catholic.com todos los años cosas como reglas de Cuaresma, ayuno de Cuaresma, reglas de ayuno católico y reglas de Cuaresma católica. Aquí están las reglas de ayuno del Miércoles de Ceniza para la Cuaresma. El Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo se deben observar la abstinencia y el ayuno.

Código de Derecho Canónico dice: Poder. 1251: Se debe observar todos los viernes la abstinencia de comer carne o cualquier otro alimento, según las prescripciones de la conferencia episcopal, a menos que una solemnidad caiga en viernes. El Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo se deben observar la abstinencia y el ayuno.

¿Qué son el ayuno y la abstinencia? Según el derecho canónico actual en el rito occidental de la Iglesia, un día de ayuno es aquel en el que los católicos de entre dieciocho y cincuenta y ocho años deben mantener un ayuno limitado. En este país se puede comer una sola comida normal y dos snacks. No se requiere que los niños ayunen, pero sus padres deben asegurarse de que reciban una educación adecuada en la práctica espiritual del ayuno.

Un día de abstinencia es un día en el que los católicos mayores de catorce años deben abstenerse de comer carne. (Aunque bajo la disciplina actual del rito occidental de la Iglesia, el pescado, los huevos, los productos lácteos y los alimentos elaborados con grasa animal están permitidos, no están en los ritos orientales). Su pastor puede dispensar fácilmente a aquellos con condiciones médicas de los requisitos de ayuno y abstinencia.
