MARTIN LUTHER KING DAY

Martin Luther King Jr. Day is this month. The holiday, which falls on the third Monday in January, is held near the civil rights leader's birthday on Jan. 15, 1929. It's held on a Monday to allow U.S. residents a three-day weekend.

Martin Luther King Jr. Day became a holiday on Nov. 2, 1983 after President Ronald Reagan signed a bill into law officially establishing the commemoration. The King family spent years after Martin Luther King Jr. was assassinated in 1968 campaigning for a federal holiday to honor the civil rights leader, who earned a Nobel Peace Prize in 1964 for his work to end segregation and target racism in America.

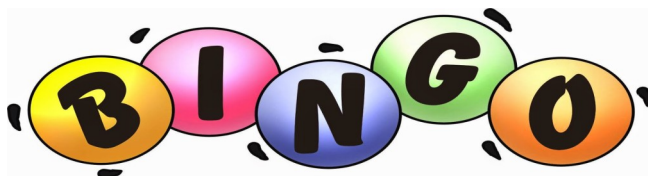

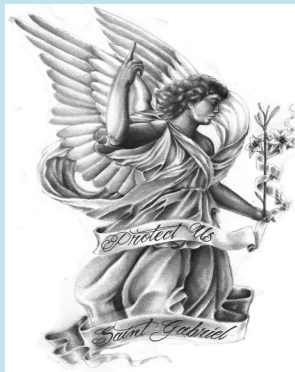
