SAINTS PETER AND PAUL, APOSTLES

Saints Peter and Paul are foundational figures in Christianity, celebrated for their roles in spreading the Gospel and establishing the early Church. Their feast day is observed on **June 29**. The Church celebrates the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul to honor the two great apostles. St. Peter, one of the Twelve and the chief of the Apostles, the Rock upon which Christ built His Church, and St. Paul “called to be an apostle, set apart for the gospel of God” [Romans 1:1] and Apostle to the Gentiles. Together they are honored as founders of the Church of Rome, having been separately martyred there during the reign of Emperor Nero.

Christian tradition has always considered Saints Peter and Saint Paul inseparable and together represent the whole Gospel of Christ. St. Peter is the patron saint of fishermen, net makers, and shipbuilders. Together with St. Paul, he is also the patron saint of Rome and the Patron Saint of Missionaries, Evangelists, Writers, and Public Workers. Peter and Paul are called the patron saints of Rome because, in the words of Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI, “The Christian community of [Rome] considered them a kind of counterbalance to the mythical Romulus and Remus; the two brothers held to be the founders of Rome.”

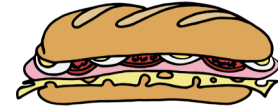

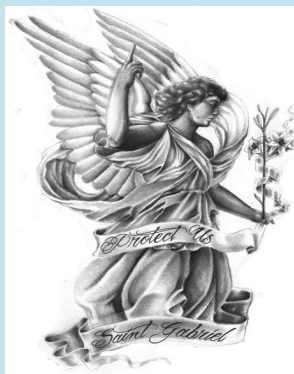

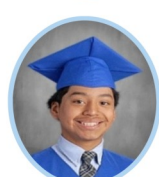
