MOTHER OF GRACE LODGE 100TH ANNIVERSARY



On **July 20, 2025 a 10:00am Mass** will be held to celebrate the 100th Anniversary of the Mother of Grace Lodge. Mass will be followed with a Procession and Benediction.

This Lodge was started in the early 1900's by many Italian people who came from Italy to America. The first celebration of the Mother of Grace Feast in Penns Grove took place on Sunday, July 2, 1925. The celebration consisted of the christening of the Mother of Grace statue in St. James Roman Catholic Church, Beach Avenue in Penns Grove. A replica of the statue from Italy is placed in the Chapel. Many of our parishioners may be related to the people who lived in Penns Grove and the surrounding areas who started this Lodge.

A banquet will be held at Maria's in Penns Grove [the old Washington Club on Virginia Avenue], which will begin at 1pm. **Tickets are \$50 for members and \$65 for non-members.** The banquet will be catered by DiPaolo's. I believe all members have, by now, received their email.

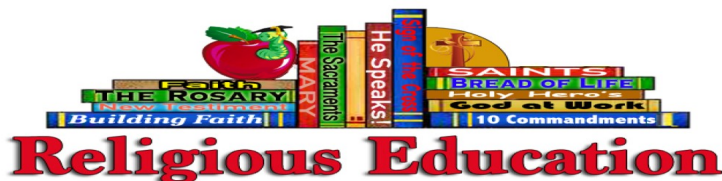

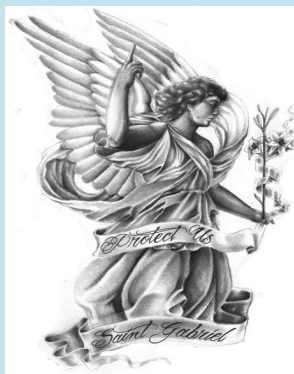
