JOACHIM AND ANNE, PARENTS OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY



Saints Anne and Joachim Feast day is July 26, and through tradition, were derived from certain apocryphal writings, the parents of the Virgin Mary. St. Anne is one of the patron saints of Brittany and Canada and of women in labour. As the grandparents of Jesus, Saints Anne and Joachim are also known as the patron saints of grandparents.

Today marks the feast of Joachim and Anne. In the second century an account of their lives appeared as the apocryphal *Protevangelium of James*, modeling their story and the joyous birth of their daughter. Anne, whose name means "Grace," was a devout woman who longed for a child. According to the Gospel of James, an angel appeared

to her with the joyous news that she would conceive a daughter who would be spoken of throughout the world. This daughter was Mary, who would become the mother of Jesus. Joachim and Anne would have wanted Mary to be strong and they would have wanted her to be loving.

We read and write stories to understand ourselves as much as to explain the past or document the present. The accounts of Mary's parents and her miraculous infancy say a lot about the hopes of the late second century. They are not canonical scripture, and there's probably a reason for that. Thomas Aquinas called them Anne's story is one of faith and divine intervention. Her veneration began in the early centuries of the Church and gained significant popularity during the Middle Ages. By the 6th century, a church in Constantinople was dedicated in her honor, highlighting her importance in Christian history.




