A friend took me to the healing service; I was more than happy. When the priest asked me what I wanted to pray over I told him my diabetes, if not, I would offer it for the priests.

Over the years, each time I had to up the dosage of the meds, I asked God to take away my diabetes. Then, God reminded me that I offered this for the priest and my reply to Him was, "The offering to the priests came from you and not me." At the time of the prayer service, the thought of the priest was not in my head nor in my heart at all. As the years went by, I started to bargain with God saying, "I will offer the whole rosary for the priests so please take away this diabetic condition because I am tired of taking all these meds." So I started to pray the 4th rosary for the priests but sometimes I don't get to finish the 4th rosary. However, I do finish the 3rd rosary because it is for my family. So one day I was thinking I need to do the 4th rosary and then I heard, "switch". I knew exactly what that meant. God knows that I will try my utmost to finish the 4th rosary because it is for my family. Also, God's love for priests shows that the first intention for the Flame of Love Rosary is to pray for our priest, so it seems to me that God wants to take care of our priests above all others.

According to St. John Vienny, when we meet a priest and an angel, we must show our respect to our priest first; according to the Pieta booklet, priesthood is a masterpiece of Christ's divine love, wisdom and power.

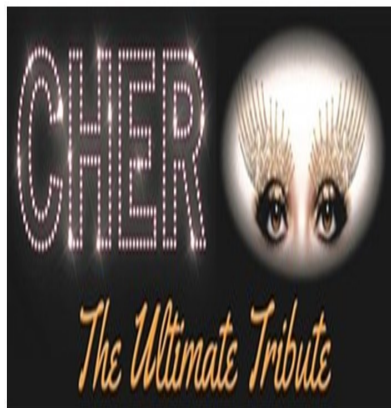

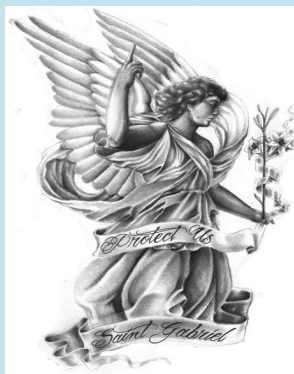

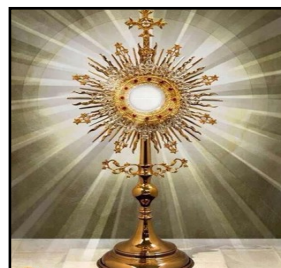

los efectos que tiene la Misa son purificadores y de reparación, esto lo encontramos en el mismo Catecismo: "En cuanto sacrificio, la Eucaristía es ofrecida también en reparación de los pecados de los vivos y los difuntos, y para obtener de Dios beneficios espirituales o temporales" (CEC 1414).

El llamado "fruto ministerial", que propiamente son los beneficios que obtienen aquellos por quienes el Sacerdote ha ofrecido una Misa en particular. 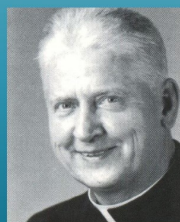
