

THE QUEENSHIP OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

On August 22nd, Catholics worldwide celebrate an extraordinary coronation – not of an earthly monarch, but of a humble girl from Nazareth who became the Queen of Heaven and Earth.

The Feast of the Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary is a relatively recent addition to the Catholic calendar, established in 1954 by Pope Pius XII. But why would the Church crown the mother of Jesus as a queen? This feast, closely linked to the Assumption [August 15th], paints a transcendent picture of Mary's journey. Tradition holds that at the end

of her earthly life, Mary was taken body and soul into heaven as a prelude to her coronation as Queen of all creation. Mary's royal title is rooted in ancient Hebrew tradition where the mother of the king held a position of unique honor and influence.

As the Mother of Jesus – whom Christians hail as the King of Kings – Mary's queenship reflects her unparalleled role in salvation history.


