### THE PASSION OF JOHN THE BAPTIST



The Memorial of the Passion of Saint John the Baptist is an important day in the Catholic Church. It is celebrated every year on **August 29th**. This day remembers the death of John the Baptist, who was a key figure in preparing people for Jesus. He is known for his strong message and his call to repentance.

John the Baptist was a prophet who lived a simple life. He wore rough clothing and ate simple food. He preached about turning away from sin and getting ready for the coming of Jesus. **He also <u>baptized</u> many people, including <u>Jesus himself</u>. John's courage in speaking the truth made him well-known, but it also led to his death.** 

The story of the Passion of Saint John the Baptist is tragic. He spoke out against King Herod's marriage, which was not allowed under Jewish law. This angered Herod's wife, Herodias. She plotted to have John killed. Through a series of events, Herodias'

daughter, Salome, asked for John's head. Herod reluctantly agreed, and John was beheaded.

The Memorial of the Passion of Saint John the Baptist is a time to remember his courage and his faithfulness. He stood up for what was right, even when it cost him his life. His example teaches us the importance of standing up for the truth. On this day, we honor his memory and the role he played in the story of Jesus.


