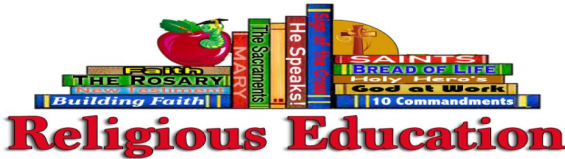
THE TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD



The transfiguration is one of the miracles of Jesus in Gospels. Thomas Aquinas considers the transfiguration "the greatest miracle", in that it complemented baptism and showed the perfection of life in Heaven. The transfiguration is one of the five major milestones in the gospel narrative of the life of Jesus, with the others being baptism, crucifixion, resurrection and ascension. In Christian teachings, the transfiguration is a pivotal moment, and the setting on the mountain is presented as the point where human nature meets God: the meeting place of the eternal, with Jesus, as both true man and true God, acting as the bridge between heaven and earth.

The Transfiguration of Jesus Christ was a powerful demonstration of His divine nature and the manifestation of His glory, which Jesus possessed prior to coming to earth in the human body. **August 6** is the day the Transfiguration is listed on the Catholic calendar.

Bible Story of the Transfiguration - "After six days Jesus took Peter, James and John with him and led them up a high mountain, where they were all alone. There He was transfigured before them. His clothes became dazzling white. And there appeared before them Elijah and Moses, who were talking with Jesus. Then a cloud appeared and covered them, and a voice came from the cloud: *"This is my Son, whom I love. Listen to him!"* Suddenly, when they looked around, they no longer saw anyone with them except Jesus. As they were coming down the mountain, Jesus gave them orders not to tell anyone what they had seen until the Son of Man had risen from the dead.." **Mark 9:2-9**

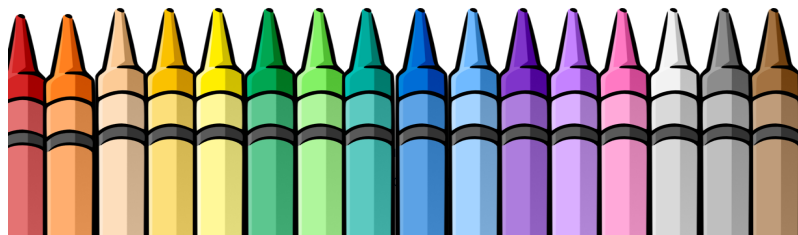

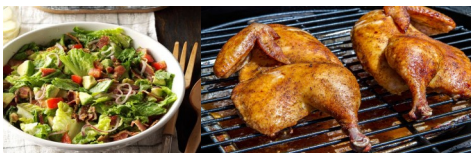


PARISH CHICKEN BARBECUE

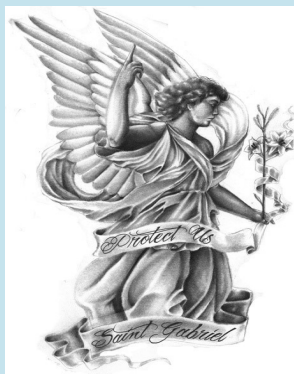


