LABOR DAY



Labor Day for the year 2025 is observed on **Monday, September 1st.** It is a United States federal holiday on the first Monday of September annually. The day celebrates the American labor movement and the contributions and achievements of the American worker. In the United States, Labor Day is the three-day weekend ending the summer season and <u>Memorial Day</u> weekend starts the summer season. Before early labor laws came into play in the 20th century, the average U.S. worker's schedule spanned 12 hours a day, 7 days a week, with low wages and little protection.

The culmination of years of strikes and protests by American workers to secure better job conditions, Labor Day was signed into law on June 28, 1894, by President Grover Cleveland.

The civilian workforce in America is around 170 million people strong as of June 2025, data from Statista shows. Many cities and states across the country have passed legislation to enforce higher minimums adjusted for today's cost of living. Most recently in July, the minimum wage was raised in 15 states and cities.


