I thought the child was Jesus but the more I looked at the face and with a "crazy hairdo", I felt the child was more like our youngest. That happy smile took away my sadness.

I believe God was helping me not to be sad when my youngest is so happy in heaven. After seeing that image, I was able to pay attention to Jesus whom I just received and thank Him. When I got up to do the concluding prayers, I thought I saw the side view of Jesus's face with a crown of thorns and I believed God wanted me to continue to console Him: I do believe that is my purpose of being on this earth.
