ALL SAINTS DAY

All Saints' Day, also known as **All Hallows' Day**, the **Feast of All Saints**, the **Solemnity of All Saints**. It is a Christian solemnity celebrated in honor of all the saints of the Church, whether they are known or unknown. From the 4th century, feasts commemorating all Christian martyrs were held in various places, on various dates near Easter and Pentecost. In the 9th century, some churches in the British Isles began holding the commemoration of all saints on **November 1**, and in the 9th century this was extended to the whole Catholic Church by Pope Gregory IV.

In Western Christianity, it is still celebrated on 1 November by the Western Catholic Church as well as by many Protestant churches, such as the Lutheran, Anglican, and Methodist traditions. The Christian celebration of All Saints' Day and All Souls' Day stems from a belief that there is a powerful spiritual bond between those in heaven (the "Church triumphant"), the living (the "Church militant"), and the "Church penitent" which includes the faithful departed.

In Catholic theology, the day commemorates all those who have attained the beatific vision in Heaven. All Saints' Day falls on 1 November and is followed by **All Souls' Day on November 2**. It is a Solemnity in the Roman Rite of the Catholic Church, Lutheran and Anglican Churches.

You have a plan for my baby." In six months, I returned with my beautiful baby for his diagnostic tests. His doctor was amazed; his little heart with the large whole had closed. No more murmur, just a tiny hint of a scar. I couldn't contain myself, and blurted out to the doctor, "God healed my son! I offered it up to God to handle and he blessed my baby!" The doctor replied, "Yes, God does heal according to his plan. It's good you are a believer, as I am too."

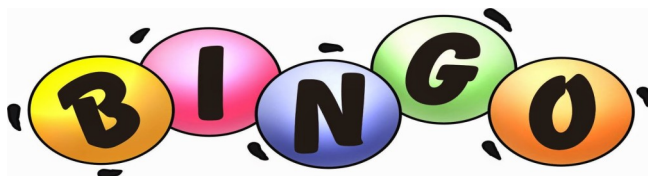

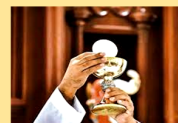
