




# EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS



The Exaltation of the Holy Cross, celebrated on **September 14**, commemorates the discovery of the True Cross and its significance in Christian faith as a symbol of salvation. On 13 September, 335, the Constantinian Basilica

over the Holy Sepulchre was consecrated in Jerusalem. The day after the church's consecration, the relic of the cross was shown ("exalted") the first time to the people for veneration.

In the liturgical year, there are several celebrations which honor and celebrate the cross used in the crucifixion. Unlike Good Friday, which is dedicated to the passion of Christ and the crucifixion, these feast days celebrate the Cross itself, as the sign of salvation. The most common day of commemoration is September 14 for churches that use the Gregorian calendar.




