

## HISTORY OF PRIESTHOOD SUNDAY SEPTEMBER 28


It began in the early 2000s when a national Catholic lay group first proposed the idea. The National Federation of Priests' Councils helped lead the early effort.

Other groups like the Knights of Columbus, vocation directors, lay ministers, and parish leaders soon became a part of this effort. Their goal was to help Catholics recognize, thank and support the priesthood more visibly. Priesthood Sunday quickly became a yearly tradition across the United States.

Local communities plan events, offer prayers and share personal thanks with their parish priests. The focus stays on the role priests play through liturgy, sacraments and spiritual guidance.

Organizers wanted lay people, not clergy, to guide the celebration. Every day, churchgoers lead planning, making announcements, preparing meals, and writing messages. That structure encourages stronger personal connections between priests and the people they serve.

The day also started deeper conversations across the country. People talked more openly about the pressures priests face, their unique role and how parishes can better support them. These talks brought attention to both the challenges and the meaning behind priesthood. Today, Priesthood Sunday continues to grow.




