Dear Bishop Kelley Community,

The Bishop Kelley Board of Directors recently met to set tuition for the 2026-2027 school year. Keeping tuition affordable for all families and ensuring access to the great education we offer is a top priority for us as a school community. Tuition for the 2026-2027 school year will be increased by **\$450**. This 3.2% increase will ensure we remain competitive with salaries and allows us to continue to maintain our campus. We value our mission-driven educators and remain committed to competitive compensation. The cost of insurance, facility maintenance, labor, utilities, vehicle maintenance, etc., has increased. We strive to be good stewards in all that we do.

The tuition rates for the 2026-27 school year will be as follows:

- **\$14,370**: Standard Tuition Rate
- **\$12,070**: Supporting a Parish Rate (**\$2,300** tuition reduction for families registered and supporting a Catholic parish in the Diocese of Tulsa and Eastern Oklahoma)
- Standard fees remain the same for all students. Grades 9-11: **\$695** and Grade 12: **\$790**

We are fortunate the State has made available The Parental Choice Tax Credit program which provides a refundable income tax credit of up to \$7,500 for eligible Oklahoma taxpayers who pay, or expect to pay, qualified expenses such as tuition and fees to an eligible private school. As a Catholic school, inspired by St. John Baptist de La Salle, we are committed to assisting our families by providing access to tuition assistance through our *Believe in Kelley* annual fund, interest earned from our Endowment Trust, and other tuition assistance funds such as St. Francis of Assisi and GO for Catholic Schools.
