General Protocols for BK Softball Field

- No locker room facilities will be available for visiting teams. Please come dressed for event.
- Water will be provided for all teams at the bench area for events.
- Patrons should sit only in designated areas in bleachers. Patrons may also sit in available areas in lawn chairs.
- Bishop Kelley will have a Certified Athletic Trainer on site for the event. Visiting teams will need to provide any taping material they need for pre-game.
- During and directly after the event, no unauthorized personnel are allowed on playing surface. Upon conclusion of athletic event, please exit the facility safely and orderly at designated exits.
- Only necessary personnel from both teams will be allowed in the dugout area for the duration of the event.
- Tickets for the event can be purchased with cash at the northwest ticket table. That is the only entrance
 for visitors who are not team personnel. There are no online ticket sales or credit card ticket sales available for BK softball events.
- Public restrooms are available in the building directly south of the softball field.


COVID-19 Related Protocols

In an effort to meet current recommendations for safety from COVID-19, the following protocols are in place.

- Do not enter school facilities if you are experiencing any of the following symptoms: Temperature over 100, persistent cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, headache, muscle/joint pain, nausea, or loss of smell/taste.
- If you have had known exposure to COVID-19 in the past 14 days or been asked to quarantine in the past 10 days and have not have a COVID-19 vaccine, you may not enter the school facility.
- Mask-wearing and social distancing are not required. However, Bishop Kelley encourages all efforts be made by individuals and communities to keep themselves and others safe and comfortable.

- In the event of inclement weather, a siren will sound to clear the facility when lightning is within a 10-mile radius. Spectators will be asked to return to their vehicles.
