## PRIEST'S CORNER

### A MESSAGE FROM FR. LARRY:

Summer days are here, and with it, summer reading. I don't know if you like fiction, non-fiction, crime, romance, or sci-fi, but it's good to get in the habit of using some of the down time of summer to find a good book or even audiobook instead of endless doomscrolling. If you find yourself wanting some spiritual reading, there are plenty of options. Myself, I have finally found a little time to start reading Pope Leo's latest encyclical, Magnifica humanitas, on the safeguarding of the human person in the time of artificial intelligence. It's a bit dense for casual beach reading, running about 60 pages. However, it is so far-ranging that there is a lot to unpack here. So, maybe my summer project for the bulletin might be to unpack it a bit in snippets. For one thing, it's important when reading a papal document to understand the starting points of his letter. Everything hinges on these starting points: The priority of God and the dignity of the human person. If you have a problem with either one of these, you won't understand what you are reading. From these flow other considerations: the common good, the principle of social justice, integral human development, the importance of truth in communication, education, peace, the value of work and employment, the economy, the family, disarmament, and multilateralism. As I said, it's a lot to unpack. But each human person is made in the image and likeness of God and has an inviolable eternal destiny. In writing the letter, Pope Leo remarks, "In offering these reflections, my hope is, first and foremost, to help the lay faithful and people of goodwill rediscover their duty of implementing the above-mentioned principles in their daily lives, family relationships, work, and involvement in society. Thus, they will let themselves be inspired by the aim of embodying God's love in the concrete events of life." In other words, these reflections are not just for bishops or technocrats, but for you and me to help form our consciences on how to live our lives amid the rapid technological and societal changes occurring around us. In world of billionaire-owned media, each one pushing their own ideology and propaganda, it's good as Catholics to remind ourselves to listen to the successor of Blessed Peter has to say. Stay tuned.
