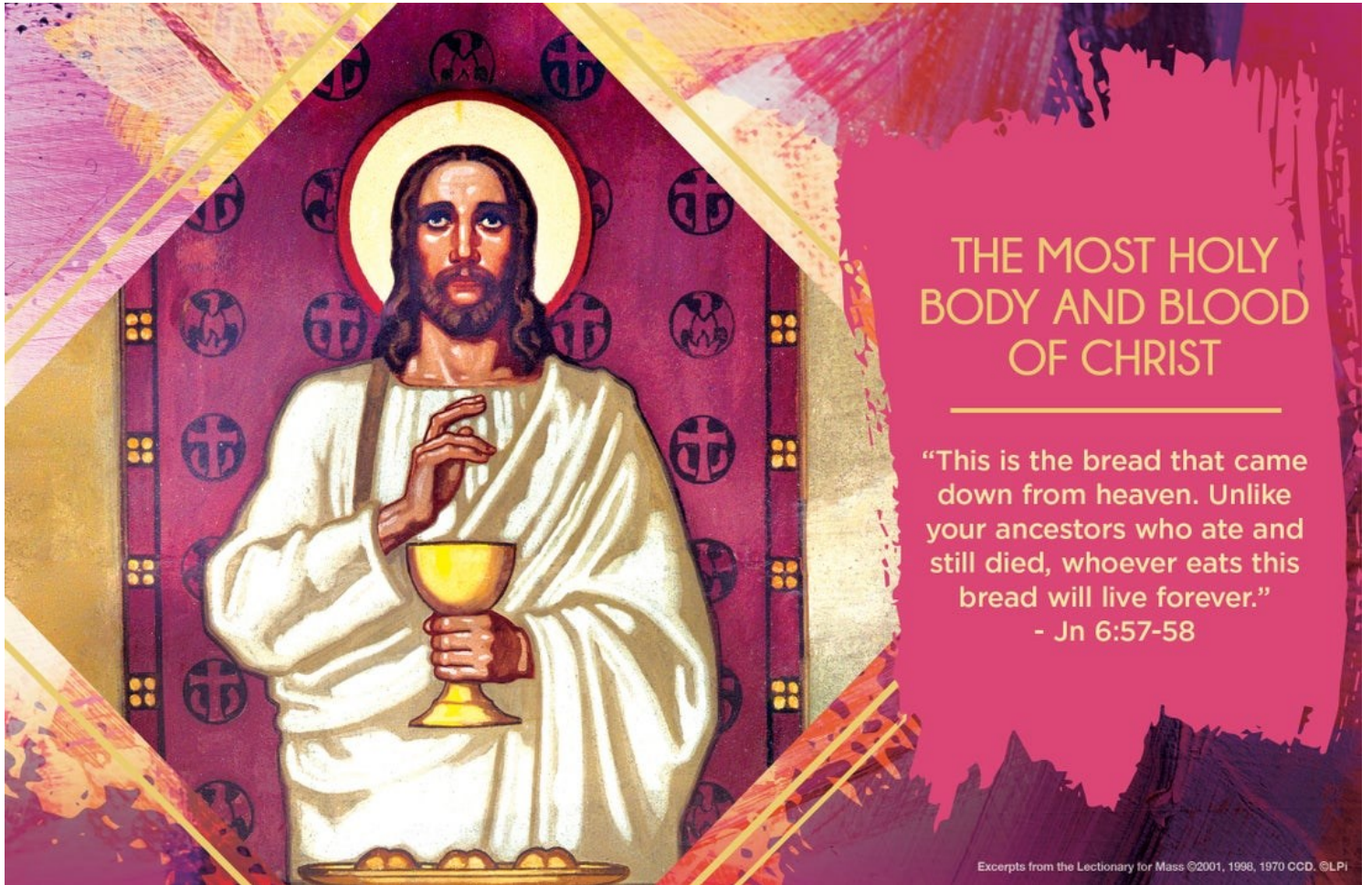

An Important Opportunity to Support Students and Families of HTCS!

Starting January 1, 2027 a new federal tax credit will allow individuals to receive a dollar-for-dollar tax credit of up to \$1700.00 for contributions that fund student scholarships at Holy Trinity Catholic school.

Our Confirmation students choose a Confirmation Saint in their 1st year of study. Students are reminded to ask their Saint for guidance in anticipation of the Sacrament of Confirmation.

St. Sebastian

St. Sebastian was born 255AD & died in 288 AD. His father was a Christian, so Sebastian kept his faith a secret when he became a soldier in the Roman Army. His faith was discovered leading to his arrest by Emperor Diocletian. He was tied to a tree & shot with arrows & left for dead. But God saved him & he went back to the Emperor to try to stop persecution of the Church. He was then beaten to death with clubs. I admire St. Sebastian because of his toughness that he survived. I chose this Saint as my Confirmation Saint because he is the patron saint of athletes, and my favorite thing to do is play basketball.
