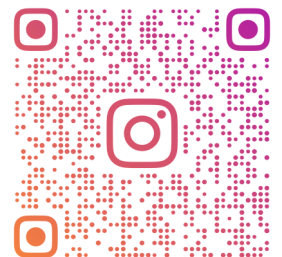
Thank you to all who attended the

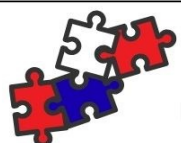

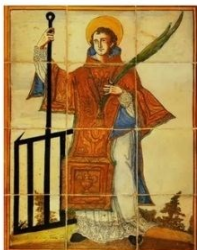

St. Lawrence of Rome

St. Lawrence was born in 225 AD in a Roman province in Spain. He became an Archdeacon under Pope Sixtus II and was in charge of the church's treasury, riches and distribution of alms to the poor. In August of 258 AD, Emperor Valerian ordered all bishops, priests, and deacons be put to death. St. Lawrence was demanded to give up the church's treasury but he distributed the wealth to the poor. This angered the prefect so he got a great gridiron with hot coals to roast St. Lawrence. He was sentenced to death in 258 AD. Tradition says when St. Lawrence was dying he said, "Turn me over, I'm done on this side" He is the patron saint of cooks, the poor, comedians, and firefighters. I admire that he was happy, comedic, generous, and kind. I chose this Saint because I want to have the generosity, kindness, and wit of St. Lawrence.

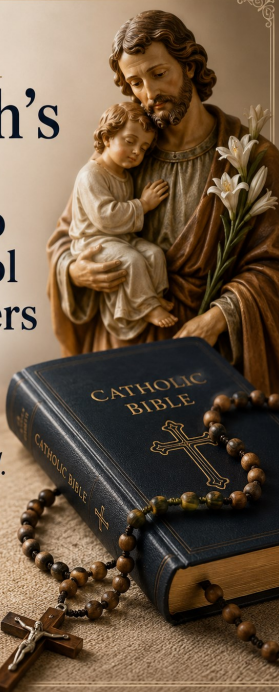
