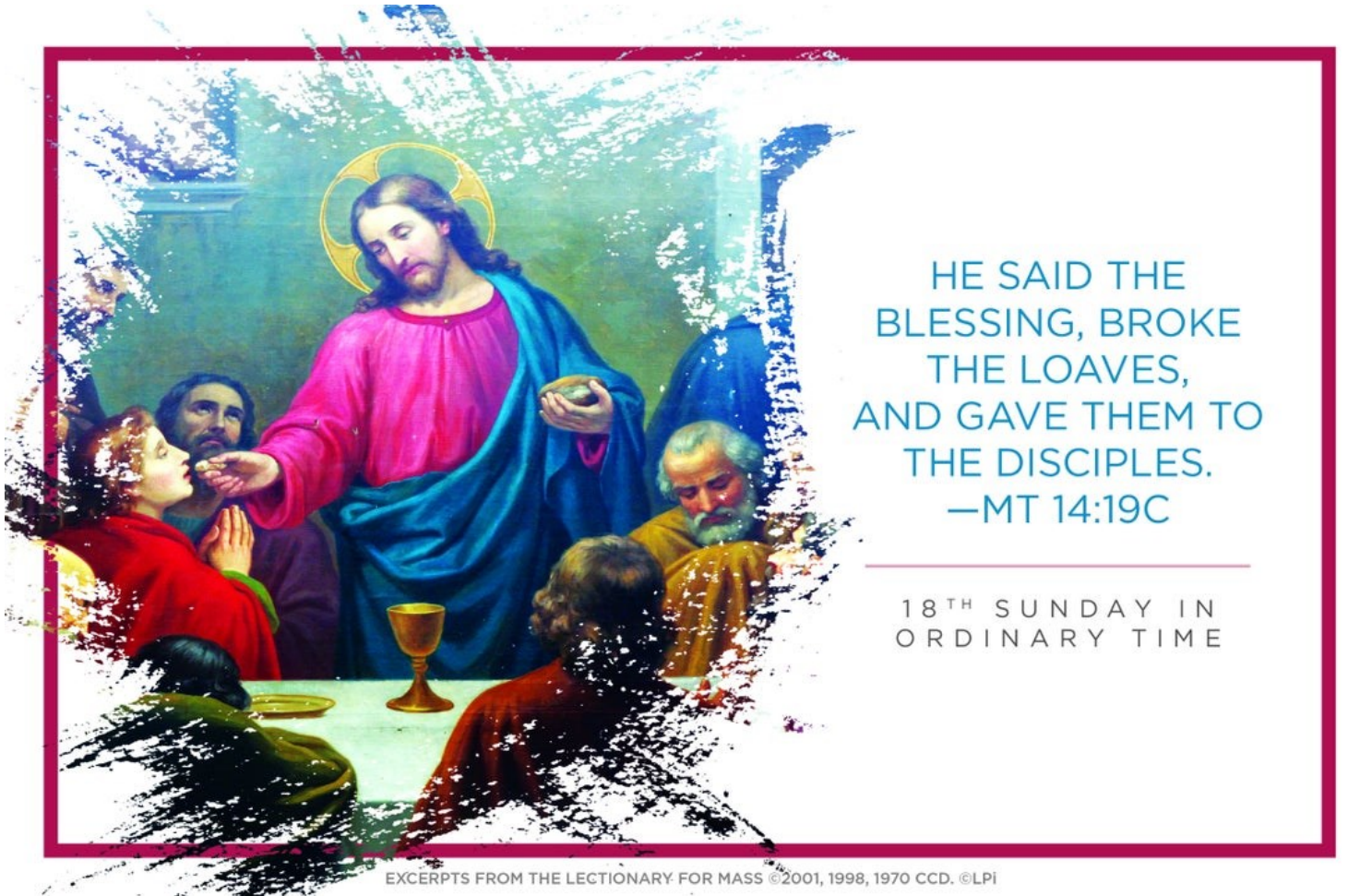

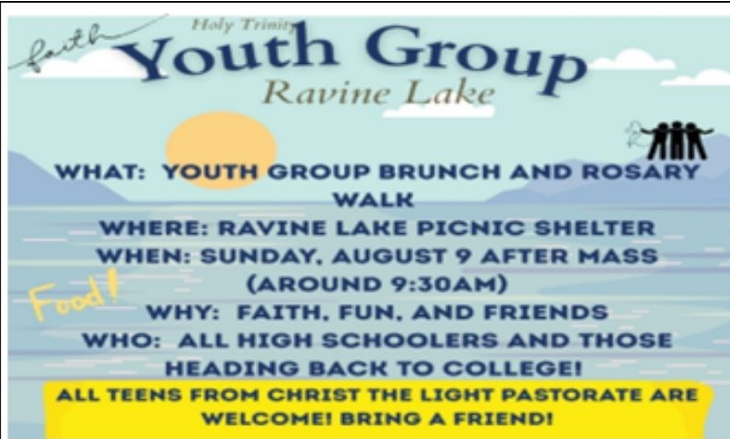

St. Margaret the Virgin

St. Margaret was born in 289 AD in Antioch, Pisidia. She was raised by a Christian nurse and was a very beautiful girl. Despite her suitors, she stayed a virgin. She was arrested for her faith and thrown in prison. She was visited by the devil in the form of a dragon. She turned to Jesus and conquered the devil. When she got out of prison, she was brought before the Roman Governor who tried to force her to renounce her faith. When she refused, she was burned and beaten. She survived all the injuries, but was then beheaded in 303 AD or 304 AD in Antioch. She is the patron saint of pregnancy, labor & childbirth. I admire St. Margaret because she was outgoing and always turned to God no matter the inconvenience. She was brave and persevered in revoking temptation.

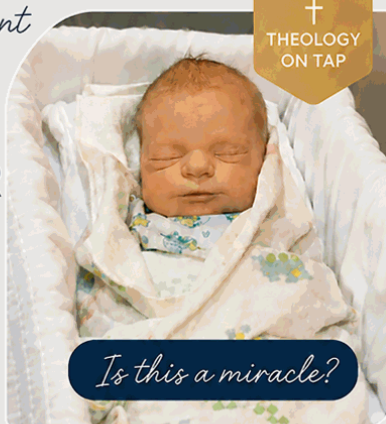
