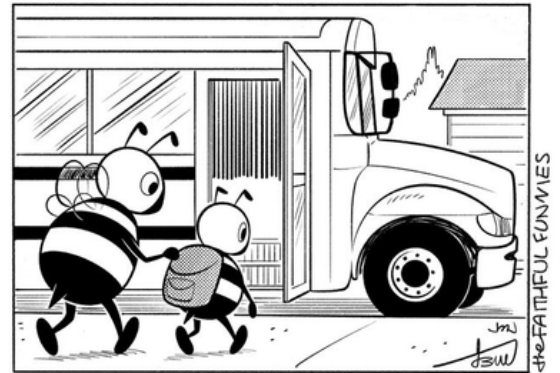

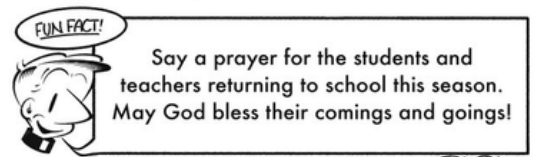

Baptism: Requires a class beforehand, if not previously attended. Holy Trinity has baptism classes on the last Sunday of the month (except in December) after 8:30a.m. Mass and after 7:00p.m. Mass in the Confirmation Room.

Next Class Date: August 30th

Marriage: Must contact the parish at least six months before marriage.

Anointing of the sick: Takes place at the church before surgery or in need.

Communion for the homebound: If you (or someone you know) is homebound, in assisted living, or in a nursing home, we have volunteers willing to bring the Eucharist to you! We have English or Spanish speaking options. Call for more information and to get on our list. If you would like to help with this ministry, please call your church office. Thank you!

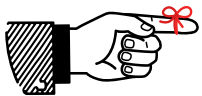

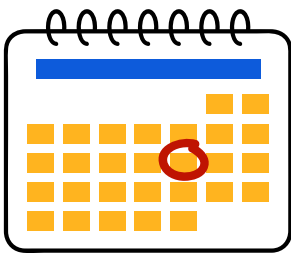

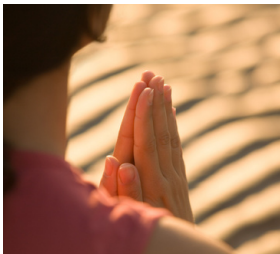
