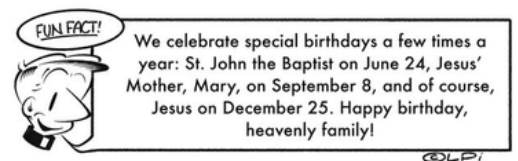

Next Class Date: September 27

Marriage: Must contact the parish at least six months before marriage.

Anointing of the sick: Takes place at the church before surgery or in need.

Communion for the homebound: If you (or someone you know) is homebound, in assisted living, or in a nursing home, we have volunteers willing to bring the Eucharist to you! 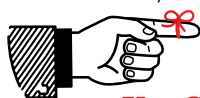

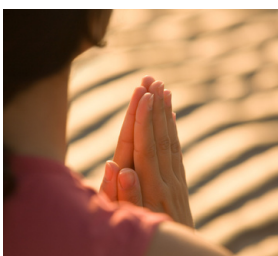
