The search committee: Barb B, Judy H, Michelle M, Amanda O, Stephanie V, Lanne R, Tim S, Stan W, and Todd P. have been meeting every 3-4 weeks since October. We have completed the church profile and have uploaded that to the CRCNA website and have also put an ad in the Banner. Due to the large number of CRC church vacancies, we also created a brochure about our church and its ministries along with some town and area information. We have sent the brochure, a job description, and the town and area information to about 10 different colleges, universities, and seminaries. We have gathered about 30 pastor profiles from the CRC website and a few pastors have sent us their information. The Living Lord's Supper

On March 28 at 7:00 pm, you are personally invited to come to MACCRAY Auditorium and witness Jesus' disciples come to life from the painting of Leonardo Da Vinci. Jesus has just announced that one of the disciples will betray him, hence the painting's unique expressions of these disciple's faces. They wrestle with truth and hope, faith and despair, confidence, and reflective doubt. Yet, the drama allows you to grasp that all followers share these same realities when we know of the fullness of Jesus' death and resurrection in our place. There are 4-mini scenes of three disciples sharing this struggle in hearing Jesus' announcement. They wrestle before your eyes, about their relationship with Jesus, how Jesus has affected their view of life in his love and leading them, and now this revelation.

This drama is written so that with each disciple you can see a little more clearly into your own relationship with Jesus. It affords you the quiet grace and space to wrestle with his invitation to a life-changing relationship with him.

In between these mini-scenes, you along with all who attend can participate or simply listen to music that can aid you in your relational moment at this time with Jesus. At the conclusion of the drama, you will have time outside the Auditorium to briefly meet any disciple that you connected with, at which time the grace of the bread and juice of communion will be offered by Bunde's Elders.
