WOVIN 111 Women Veterans served

Women remain one of the most underserved populations in the veteran community. One quarter of female veterans have children. MHVI provides emergency food, housing referrals, health and wellness programs and advocacy for women veterans experiencing domestic violence.

Tuna, crackers, peanut butter, fruit cups, puddings, cereal, soups, juices, waters and more were provided in portable packages and bags for veterans and families who arrive at MHVI on foot, by bus or car. We provide food in crisis situations and frequently deliver food to homebound and disabled veterans.

"It's just us..."

Two-year old Tiana and her father Michael, a US Marine Corp veteran, arrived at the Milwaukee Homeless Veterans Initiative for assistance. "It's just us," he said, talking through the lobby glass, "me and my daughter. We have nothing."

Due to extenuating circumstances Michael and Tiana's mother were not together. Unbeknownst to him, Tiana's mother dropped her off at a relative's house and didn't come back to get her. Michael received a call to pick Tiana up, which he immediately did. However, she had no clothes, diapers, or toddler appropriate food.

With nowhere else to turn, Michael came to MHVI for help. Because of the many individuals who generously donate food, clothes and other in-kind items we were able to help Michael and Tiana. We provided food, toiletry items, diapers, juice, water and clothes for both. We also gave him a Goodwill voucher to buy items we didn't have. Before they left, we found one last item that put a smile on everyone's face; a blue-finned mermaid doll in a shimmering jacket that was given to Tiana. She grinned from ear to ear and held it tight. Michael was extremely grateful for the assistance.

"This family is starting over," said Debbie Buchanan, MHVI Executive Director. "MHVI exists for this very reason; to be a lifeboat when the waves get too high or after a shipwreck. We're honored to be part of helping them reach safety."

Since then, Michael has returned for case management services and help with referrals to additional services. We are happy we are able to help veterans like Michael in their time of need.

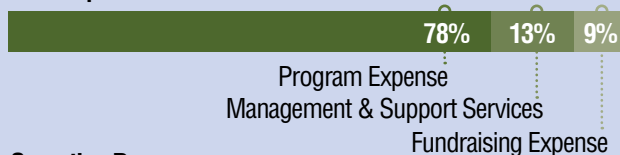
