

WISCONSIN HOMELESS VETERANS INITIATIVE





HIGHLIGHTS

In May, 2026, MHVI changed our name to Wisconsin Homeless Veterans Initiative (WHVI). While our name changed, our commitment to services remains the same. WHVI meets veterans where they are, providing support and services they need to thrive. Together with the veterans we serve, we celebrated many successes in 2024 and 2025 several of which are highlighted in this report. Most importantly, we remain steadfast in our mission, *to enable homeless and at-risk veterans to reach and maintain their highest levels of independence.*

MHVI Programs

Our programs are designed to be flexible allowing veterans to access the services and support they need when they need them most. WHVI's core services include Community Education and Outreach, Furnishings for Heroes, Crisis Management, Emergency Food Pantry, Veterans Resource Post, Bikes for Stripes, and the Women Veterans Independent Network (WOVIN). We continue to listen to the needs of the veterans we serve and adapt our programming to better support their independence, stability, and long-term success.

Program Highlights

Crisis Management: The Crisis Management program assists veterans facing immediate challenges by helping remove barriers and connect them with the resources needed to achieve both short- and long-term goals. Services are tailored to each veteran's individual circumstances and often include support with basic needs, referrals to community resources, and connections to additional services.

- In 2024, we served 1,538 veterans, 243 spouses/partners and 403 children.
- In 2025 we served 1,234 veterans, 237 spouses/partners and 420 children.

Women's Veterans Independent Network (WOVIN):

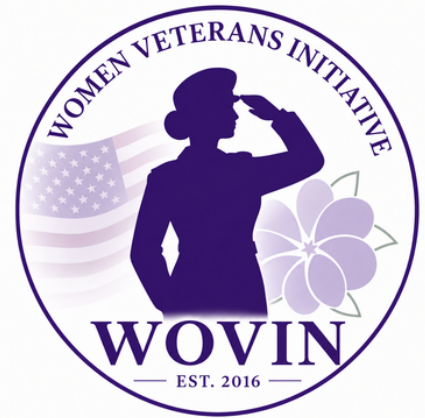
Women veterans remain one of the most underserved populations in the veteran community. Many of the women WHVI serves also have children, and our support extends to their families as well. Through WOVIN, WHVI provides emergency food, housing referrals, health and wellness programs, and advocacy for women veterans experiencing domestic violence.

- In 2024, 194 women were served.
- In 2025, 217 women were served

Furnishings for Heroes: Safe and stable housing is one of the most common needs among the veterans we serve. WHVI helps veterans secure housing and then works to ensure they have the essentials needed to make that housing a home. Through generous in-kind donations, we provide furniture, household items, bedding, and other necessities—and deliver these items directly to veterans.

- In 2024, we delivered household items to 144 veterans.
- In 2025, we served 109 veterans

These service numbers do not include the many veterans who visit WHVI's office to obtain needed items, which are reflected in the Veterans Resource Post totals.



Program Highlights

Veterans Resource Post: This store-like environment provides the opportunity for veterans to shop at no cost for new and gently used items. Available items include winter clothing, household goods, infant and children's items, hygiene products, pet food, and other necessities.

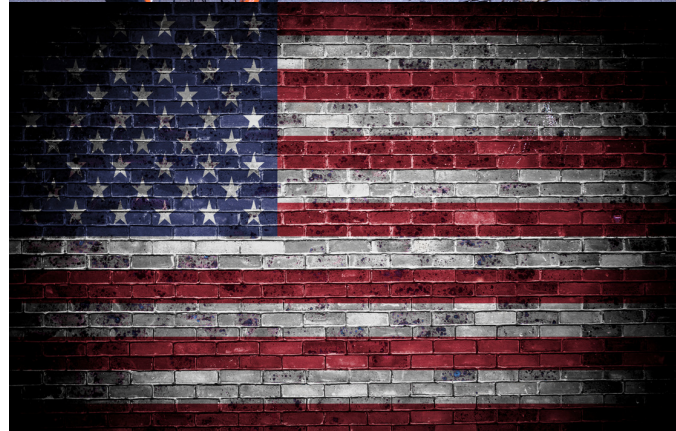
- **In 2024, 81 veterans utilized the Post**
- **In 2025, 131 veterans utilized the Post**

Emergency Food Pantry: WHVI's Emergency Food Pantry helps ensure that veterans and their families have access to food during times of short-term crisis. Each year, WHVI distributes more than 130,000 pounds of food, all provided at no cost to families.

- **In 2024, we served 976 families**
- **In 2025, we served 712 families**

Bikes for Stripes: Transportation is a key factor in helping veterans reach their goals. Through Bikes for Stripes, WHVI receives donated bicycles that are refurbished by volunteers and provided to veterans. Helmets and bike locks are also supplied to promote safety and reliability.

- **In 2024, we provided bikes, helmets and locks to 202 veterans.**
- **In 2025 we provided bikes, helmets and locks to 183 veterans and their children.**



Program Highlights Summary

In 2024 and 2025, WHVI continued to provide flexible, responsive support to veterans and their families through programs that address crisis needs, housing stability, food security, transportation, and access to essential household and personal items. Through Crisis Case Management, WHVI served thousands of veterans, spouses or partners, and children by helping remove immediate barriers and connecting families with needed resources. WOVIN expanded support for women veterans, serving more women in 2025 than in 2024. Furnishings for Heroes helped veterans make housing feel like home by delivering essential household items, while the Veterans Resource Post saw increased use as veterans accessed free clothing, hygiene products, household goods, and other necessities. WHVI's Emergency Food Pantry continued to be a vital resource, distributing more than 130,000 pounds of food annually, and Bikes for Stripes helped reduce transportation barriers by providing refurbished bicycles, helmets, and locks to veterans and their children.

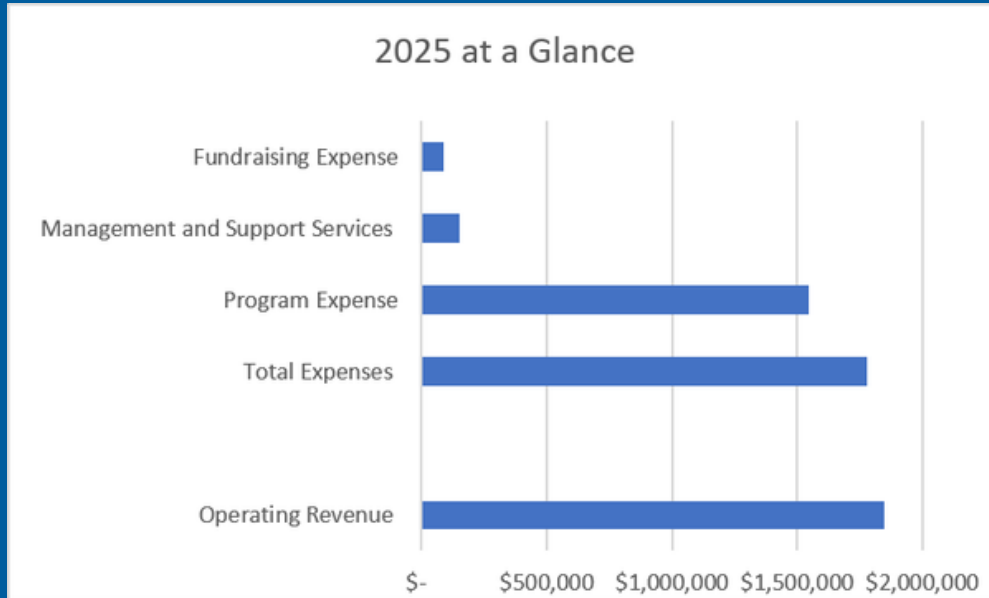
