

2025-2026 Book Process

Here you will find step by step instructions for purchasing books and other materials for the 2025-2026 school year.

1. Course List

The first thing you will want to do is consult your **Course List**. This list tells you what courses you will be taking during the 2025–2026 school year. Your **Course List** will be emailed to you on **July 14, 2025**.

2. Book List

Once you know what courses you are taking, you will want to consult the **Grade 9-12 Book List**. The Book List is organized by subject area and by course. It will tell you exactly what books and materials you need and where to find them. This year's **Book List** will be finalized and published on the **New Student Information webpage**¹ on our website on **July 16, 2025**.

3. Purchase Materials

Now that you know what books and materials you need, you can begin purchasing. For some materials, a direct link to purchase can be found on the Book List. Unless otherwise noted, families are encouraged to purchase required books and materials through Amazon or Barnes and Nobles. Families can purchase items through other vendors as well. When purchasing, please make sure to select the correct edition that matches the ISBN code listed.

Grade 9-12 NHS Book Rental Program

The National Honor Society will run a book rental program. Students in Grades 9–12 or their parents will be able to rent books in person during the month of August on 8/2, 8/9, or 8/30. A list of books available for rent will be released in late June. Rentals are \$10 per book (cash or check). Rentals are first come, first serve. Fontbonne Planner – All students are required to purchase a Fontbonne Academic Planner. The \$15 Fontbonne planner fee will be added to your FACTS account the week of July 14.

Chromebook Insurance – Every student is required to purchase Chromebook Insurance for their school-issued Chromebook. This is required for all students in grades 7 – 11. Grade 12 students continuing the Chromebook program must also purchase Chromebook Insurance. The \$30 Chromebook Insurance fee will be added to your FACTS account the week of July 14.

Additional Supplies – For students in Grades 9–12, we do not offer a full list of supplies as each course requires different materials. Students in Grades 9–12 will receive a list of required supplies for each of their classes on the first day of school. We recommend **all students** bring a notebook and writing materials to the first day of classes.
